Demonstrator Guidelines – Data for Policy 2017

- 1. All demonstrators must bring their own equipment (laptops, chargers, usb's etc.). If they wish, demonstrators may also give out hard copies/photocopies related to their demonstration, but these should be brought by demonstrators themselves
- 2. All demonstrators will be provided with an area to host their demonstration, including a presentation table. Demonstrators may place their handouts or other materials on these tables for attendee viewing.
- 3. All demonstrations are to be static, but attendees will not be seated and will move between demonstrations as their interests dictate.
- 4. It is advisable that demonstrators keep their demonstrations to at most **5 minutes** demonstrators may repeat this demonstration as many times as they wish as attendees move between the different demonstrations.
- 5. There are ample opportunities during breaks, lunches and other networking activities for further debate/discussion. Hence, all the participants are requested to utilise these times.
- 6. Focusing on interactivity may help to make your presentation more accessible to the audience.
- 7. Depending on permission being granted by the venue hosts, you may wish to record or photograph your demonstrations.
- 8. Photography and video-recording by the Conference Team will also take place in order to use for post-conference publications and other related online/printed material to be produced by Data for Policy Team.
