

Guidelines for Audience & Participants

The following guidelines are recommendations for audience participants at the conference:

1. Kindly reach the venue on time. There are several parallel sessions that will be held simultaneously in different rooms. As such, participants should choose which panels they will attend in advance and plan accordingly.
2. There will be plenty of opportunities to debate, ask questions and share your views. Kindly use these opportunities constructively. In addition to Question & Answer sections, there are other opportunities during breaks and other networking times for further discussions and private conversations.
3. Kindly avoid using mobile phones during the sessions. However, you are encouraged to send social media updates about the discussions in the session.
4. Unless advised otherwise by the Session Chair, you are allowed to take photographs, video, and audio record, provided it will not be used for commercial purposes.
5. Photography and video recording by the Conference Team will also take place for usage in post-conference publications and other related online/printed material. *Please inform session chairs and conference volunteers in the room if you have any reservations about this.*
6. If you are one of the speakers yourself, kindly reach the allocated room at least 10 minutes in advance. This will help you to transfer your data/files to the computer and check if everything is in order.
7. Kindly inform the conference organisers in advance if you have any specific requirement for your health and safety.
