




Guidance for using EasyChair to submit reviews for Data for Policy 2024

Thank you for agreeing to review submissions to Data for Policy 2024. We hope that this will be a straightforward and rewarding process.

Before submitting your review on EasyChair, please make sure you have read the [information for reviewers](#) on our website. Please note that this year, full papers will reviewed using the Data & Policy ScholarOne System, for which there is separate guidance.

1) On EasyChair, find the submission to review


