

Event Cancellation Due to Force Majeure

Data for Policy is not liable for cancelling, rescheduling, or postponing the Data for Policy Conferences due to a force majeure event, unforeseen circumstance, or any situation that makes holding the conference impracticable, illegal, or impossible. For this policy, force majeure includes, but is not limited to, war, fire, labour strikes, extreme weather, terrorist activity, pandemics, or other emergencies beyond our control. In such cases:

- **Registration Fees**: No refunds will be issued, as these fees support Data for Policy's not-for-profit mission and cover non-recoverable costs.
- **Travel Expenses**: Data for Policy is not responsible for reimbursing travel-related costs (e.g., flights, accommodation, or other expenses) incurred by attendees.
- **Credits**: Where possible, we will provide credits toward a future Data for Policy event or online access to conference materials, at our discretion.

Attendee Cancellations

- If you register under an incorrect fee category, your payment will be refunded, and you will be required to re-register using the correct type.
- Presenters will be eligible for a full refund of the registration fee until the registration deadline for presenters, while all other delegates will be able to receive a full refund until the registration deadline for all delegates.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations after these dates, or for no-shows.

- Attendance scholarships may be available but cannot be confirmed at this time.
- All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to <u>team@dataforpolicy.org</u> prior to the respective deadlines.
